RANGE AND TRAINING REGULATIONS

OIC/RSO Requirements

1. A safety Brief shall be conducted prior to each live fire event to all participants.
2. All personnel shall wear required PPE during all training events.
3. OIC Requirement – NOT REQUIRED FOR MCCS ACTIVITIES.
4. RSO Requirements - GS-05 and Above
5. IOT occupy this range unit shall have the following personnel/equipment:
 - a. RSO
 - b. Positive Communication with LONGRIFLE
 - c. Corpsman & Safety Vehicle. **Not Required for MCCS activities.**
6. IOT go into a **hot status** on range unit shall have the following personnel/equipment:
 - a. RSO
 - b. Corpsman & Safety Vehicle. **Not Required for MCCS activities.**
 - c. Positive Communication with LONGRIFLE.
7. The RSO shall personally observe each event.
8. Ammunition shall only be issued per event.
9. After each event the RSO shall conduct a line out.
10. RSO shall certify that all weapons are in Condition 4 prior to exiting the range/facility and all ammunition is accounted for.
11. All weapon malfunctions shall be corrected per the appropriate manufactures recommendations.

Special Instructions

- 1) All firing shall be supervised by a qualified Camp Pendleton RSO.
 - a) Prior to requesting a hot status, the RSO shall ensure the following are completed. Barriers with impact signs and flags are placed at the following grids. Sign #1 [68170 86717](#) sign #2 [68391 87120](#), a range flag raised at grid. [68221 86642](#) and the impact area is clear of all personnel and aircraft.
- 2) **An adult, 18 years or older, must accompany any user under the age of 16 when using this Range.**
- 3) Trapping, killing, wounding, or mistreating any wild or domesticated animal is prohibited.
- 4) **“Cracker Rounds” are authorized for use by Base Game Wardens for Familiarization Fire purposes only.**
 - a) **All effects of rounds must be confined to the range footprint.**
- 5) Trap Range #2 is in conflict with the pattern board, simultaneous operations are not authorized.
- 6) The pattern board target holder shall be constructed of wood only and shall not be engaged at a distance less than 15 yards.
- 7) Maximum fan angle for the trap launcher shall be limited to a total of 45 degrees to the left and right of the angle created by lane #3 of the trap range.
- 8) The lateral limits for both skeet ranges shall be acquired from firing position #1 for the right limit and #7 for the left limit.
- 9) The lateral limits for both trap ranges shall be acquired from the 27- yard line firing point on lane #1 for the right limit and the 27-yard line firing point on lane #5 for the left limit.
- 10) A safety brief shall be conducted by the RSO which covers, but is not limited to, weapons handling, range fan limits, range conflicts, emergency procedures, aircraft awareness and adjacent range activities.
- 11) Dry firing is authorized from established range firing points only.
- 12) Shotguns shall be pointed down-range at all times while occupying a firing position on a range.
- 13) Shotguns shall not be loaded until the shooter is in a firing position and the down-range area is clear. Only one shooter at a time shall have his/her weapon loaded at any given time. All shooters participating in the course of fire shall be located at the same firing point while all remaining personnel remain clear of the range while firing is in progress.
- 14) No personnel shall move forward of firing points #1, #7 and #8 on either skeet range while the adjacent skeet range is in a hot status.
- 15) Personnel on trap range #1 shall not move forward of the 16-yard line while skeet range #2 is in a hot status.
- 16) Empty shotgun shell casings shall be collected and properly disposed of immediately after firing.
- 17) Shooting is permitted at conventional targets (**clay pigeons**) only.
