GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- A safety Brief will conducted prior to each live fire event to all participants.**
- IOT occupy this range unit must have the following personnel/equipment:
 - RSO
 - Corpsman & Safety Vehicle
 - Positive Communication with LONGRIFLE
 - If ammunition is present on range - Ammo Guards will be armed.
- IOT go into a hot status on range unit must have the following personnel/equipment:
 - OIC
 - RSO
 - Corpsman & Safety Vehicle
 - Positive Communication with LONGRIFLE
- RSO will verify the left and right lateral limits utilizing a compass and map.**
 - Overall range lateral limits will be identified.
 - Each firing position lateral limits will be identified.
- The RSO & OIC will personally observe each live fire event.
- A signed ORM must be on hand IOT conduct training.**
- A non-participating Corpsman will be stationed with safety vehicle.**
- A full rehearsal will be conducted prior to live fire.**
- Unit is required mark/post signs for any lateral limits and/or MSLs listed in this brief if not already marked/posted.**
- Minimum engagement distances for RETS or PITS targets is as follows:**
 - 25 meters – 5.56mm
 - 100 meters – 7.62mm and above
- At no time will any unit go from live fire to blank or SESAMS force-on-force within a 24 hour period**
- At any time Range guards are required, they will be posted in pairs with positive communication with the RSO.**
- Ammunition will only be issued per event and accounted for on NAVMC 11381.
- After each event, unit leaders will conduct a line out.
- Each RSO will certify to the OIC that all weapons are in Condition 4 prior to exiting the range and all ammunition is accounted for.
- Ensure all weapons are cleared and inspected prior to departing the firing line.
- All weapon malfunctions shall be corrected per the appropriate TM/FM, and unit SOP.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

- While conducting rehearsals and live fire with small arms, the RSO will ensure:
 - No one will engaged a target that is closer than 1 meter from any muzzle.
 - All targets will placed below the red line.
 - No targets will be placed on a seam.**
 - At no time will any targets be placed on any wall that has a door or window to the outside.
 - Small arms muzzles shall be kept below the red line.
- All personnel shall conduct a non live-fire rehearsal prior to conducting live-fire scenarios.**
- All personnel shall wear a flak jacket, helmet, hearing protection, and ballistic eye protection.**
- The PSOs will accompany personnel as they execute both the rehearsal and the live-fire scenario.
- All breaching operations must be briefed to and approved by the RCO.**
