2. POC is the SNCOIC at (760) 725-3436/4035
3. Once approval from MTB has been given, unit will utilize RFMSS to schedule range.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. **A safety Brief will be conducted prior to each live fire event to all participants.**
2. **All personnel shall wear required PPE during all training events.**
3. **OIC & RSO Requirements -**
 - a. **Live Fire**
 - i. **OIC Requirement –SSgt or Above**
 - ii. **RSO Requirement - Sgt or Above**
 - b. **No Munitions**
 - i. **OIC Requirement – None**
 - ii. **RSO Requirement - Cpl or Above**
 - iii. **LASER (If Used) LSSO Requirement - Sgt or Above**
4. IOT **occupy** this range unit must have the following personnel/equipment:
 - a. RSO
 - b. Non-Participating Corpsman & Safety Vehicle
 - c. Positive Communication with LONGRIFLE
 - d. **An ORM reviewed and signed by the Command, RSO and OIC**
5. IOT go into a **hot status** on range unit must have the following personnel/equipment:
 - a. OIC
 - b. RSO
 - c. **LSSO – If using Laser**
 - d. Non-Participating Corpsman & Safety Vehicle
 - e. Positive Communication with LONGRIFLE
 - f. **NAVMC 11381 filled out by the OIC**
6. The RSO & OIC shall personally observe each event.
7. **There shall be additional safety personnel assigned as follows:**
 - a) Weapons Qualified PSOs
 - i) Daylight - shall be assigned one per every **FOUR** Shooters on firing line.
 - ii) Night - shall be assigned one per every **TWO** Shooters on firing line.
8. Ammunition will only be issued per event and accounted for on NAVMC 11381.
9. After each event, unit leaders will conduct a line out.
10. Each RSO/PSO shall certify to the OIC that all weapons are in Condition 4 prior to exiting the range/facility and all ammunition is accounted for.
11. All weapon malfunctions shall be corrected per the appropriate TM/FM, and unit SOP.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. **POVs are authorized to park in parking lot area without a POV pass.**
 - a. Personnel shall proceed either on foot or by military vehicle to firing positions, targets, and range butts area.
 - b. Civilian vehicles **shall NOT be used** for this purpose.
 - c. Range Personnel vehicles are authorized at all locations on the range.
 - d. Only the Safety vehicle and the ammo shall be allowed to remain down range behind the firing line, all other Vehicles must be moved back to the parking lot.
2. **When firing from 600 yard line, no personnel or vehicles are allowed past the 600 yard line and no access is allowed in the deep portion of the parking lot.**
3. When firing 7.62mm an air sentry shall be designated by the RSO to observe for aircraft entering into the range surface danger zone. In the event an aircraft enters the range surface danger zone, an immediate cease fire shall be conducted and LONGRIFLE notified. Firing shall not continue until cleared by LONGRIFLE.
4. RSO/OIC must maintain a vigilant observation of the firebreak in the Range 103 impact area for any unauthorized personnel entering and crossing the range surface danger zone. In the event of any personnel entering the range surface danger zone, an immediate cease fire shall be conducted and LONGRIFLE notified. Firing shall not continue until cleared by LONGRIFLE.
5. When firing 7.62mm, only the 200 yard lines to the 600 yard lines shall be utilized. **Long Range Ammunition is not authorized.**
6. **Civilian Gun Club Operations –**
 - a. **Small Bore Match:**
 - i. Firing line will be the 100 yard line.
 - ii. Targets will be placed, at same elevation as shooter, on 1"X 2" uprights at distances of 50 yards and 100 yards.
 - iii. When scoring targets, the firing line will be cleared and open bolt indicators placed in the chamber while personnel are down range.
