



NOTABLE LIMITATIONS: CAL Site 4 is located in close proximity to Camp Deluz and lies in the middle of the Deluz TERF route. Coordinate with LONGRIFLE prior to use. *During periods of rain this site may become part of the Deluz Creek and will thus be unusable.*

Overall Description of zone: CAL Site 4 is located in Deluz Creek and is surrounded by trees. The surface is very rocky, mixed with sand, but EAPS should have no problem discarding these particles. Approaches and Departures can only be made from/to the north and south respectively. This is a true CAL site.

Environmental Issues: This site is located in Arroyo Toad and riparian habitat.
