GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. **A safety Brief will conducted prior to each live fire event to all participants.**
 2. IOT occupy this range unit must have the following personnel/equipment:
 - a. RSO
 - b. Corpsman & Safety Vehicle
 - c. Positive Communication with LONGRIFLE
 - d. If ammunition is present on range - Ammo Guards will be armed.
 3. IOT go into a hot status on range unit must have the following personnel/equipment:
 - a. OIC
 - b. RSO
 - c. Corpsman & Safety Vehicle
 - d. Positive Communication with LONGRIFLE
 4. The RSO & OIC will personally observe each live fire event.
 5. **A signed ORM approved by the RCO must be on hand IOT conduct training.**
 6. **A non-participating Corpsman will be stationed with safety vehicle.**
 7. **A full rehearsal will be conducted prior to live fire.**
 8. **At no time will any unit go from live fire to blank or SESAMS force-on-force within a 24 hour period**
 9. **At any time Range guards are required, they will be posted in pairs with positive communication with the RSO.**
 10. Ammunition will only be issued per event and accounted for on NAVMC 11381.
 11. After each event, unit leaders will conduct a line out.
 12. Each RSO will certify to the OIC that all weapons are in Condition 4 prior to exiting the range and all ammunition is accounted for.
 13. Ensure all weapons are cleared and inspected prior to departing the firing line.
 14. All weapon malfunctions shall be corrected per the appropriate TM/FM, and unit SOP.
 15. Weapons cleaning gear is hazardous waste, and shall not be not placed in the trash. The items should be collected and returned to their HazMat representative, or to their local Armory for proper disposal. Unit/Area representatives are below.
- AREA = 25, 33, 41, 43, 51, 52, 62, 63, and 64 - (725-0213)
 AREA = Mainside, 22, 23, 26 and H (Hospital) - (725-9745)
 AREA = Camp Del Mar, and 20 - (725-9742)

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Tracked vehicles must stay clear from the prepared firing positions and are only permitted to conduct firing from the right side of the firing line.
2. **.50 Caliber Weapons Lateral Limits**
 - a. **Left - 344° mag**
 - b. **Right - 350° mag**
3. Range guards are required in pairs with positive communication with the RSO on the road at **6298 9029** and **6338 9023** when firing weapon systems with back blast. No traffic/personnel shall enter the range without the RSO's permission.
4. Back blast weapons shall be fired from the extreme right of the firing line only at grid 63271 90488.
5. Orange/White barriers outside the lateral limits are not authorized for engagement.
6. All M249/M240G BZO and 10 meter qualification will be conducted using pallet from the field firing line.
 - a. Any engineer stakes used for pallets must be placed on the outside edges of the pallets.
9. **For all EMP training**
 - a. Targets are only permitted to be placed, on the right side of the prepared firing line.
 - b. All EMP targets must be of softwood uprights, cardboard backing paper or cardboard targets.
 - c. Any metal bases used must be soft metal.
