The mission of Marine Corps Installations West is to provide the highest-quality facilities to train Marines to defend our country and to provide a safe community for our Marine families. To provide these facilities, we must ensure reliable and affordable sources of energy and water.

Our nation has been at war for more than ten years, where the cost of energy is tangible to Marines every day – both in the cost of delivered fuel to forward operating bases and in the number of casualties inflicted on convoys making the deliveries. To better prepare our Marines for the implications of energy reliance, it is essential to develop a true energy *ethos* in all of us, a clear understanding and genuine appreciation of the importance of energy – a true energy *ethos*.
