1. This Letter establishes procedures for the nomination and enrollment of students to the Corporals Course for Fiscal Year 2014 in accordance with the reference. The designated class dates are:

2. Students must meet the following criteria:

a. 6-Month Minimum. The nominee must have at least six months of service left after graduation or have an enlistment package pending (as verified on the screening checklist).

b. Full Duty. The nominee must be in a full duty status, verified by a medical officer or a qualified Independent Duty Corpsman

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when a medical officer is not available. The Marine must meet body composition standards verified by the unit's Physical Fitness Representative.

c. No Personal or Financial Problems. The nominee must have no personal or financial problems that will interfere with the training curriculum.

d. Serviceable Uniforms and Accessories. All uniforms and accessories listed in the enclosures must be serviceable and belong to the nominee.

3. Nominations. The nominations are due by the Friday prior to the class report date. If commands do not submit their nominations by 1300 the Friday prior to before the convening date, then those commands will lose their seats. Nominations for the subordinate elements of 1st Marine Division, I MEF Headquarters Group, 1st Marine Logistics Group, 3rd Marine Aircraft Wing, Marine Corps Installations-West/Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, Marine Corps Air Station, Miramar and Marine Corps Recruit Depot San Diego are submitted via their respective G-3/S-3 training sections. All other units submit nominations directly to the Operations Chief, Corporals Course at DSN 365-2074 or commercial (760) 725-2074.

4. Reporting:

a. Time: 0700-1000.

b. Place: Building #21441, Camp Del Mar (21 Area)

c. Uniform: Students will check-in in their Service "A" uniform or service equivalent for sister service students.

5. Required reporting items:

a. Armed Forces Identification Card.

b. Temporary Additional Duty orders.

c. Health records.

d. Screening checklist (signed and completed no earlier than 30 days prior to class report date).

e. Meal card (if applicable).

f. Service Record Books are not required.

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6. Walk-ins are welcome and assigned a seat on a first-come, first-served basis. Walk-ins must have all the required items and will be given a seat after all nominated students have checked-in. No walk-in will be given a seat until all scheduled students are processed. Walk-ins are normally processed after 1000 on the convene date but must report prior to 1100.

7. TAD orders to attend the school are issued at no expense to the government (travel is an exception for some commands). Billeting is provided. Messing is available in Camp Del Mar. Units from out of the Camp Pendleton area with Marines that require billeting on the Sunday prior to the report date must notify the Operations Section the week prior.

8. Graduation ceremonies are held at the Staff Noncommissioned Officer Academy BLDG 524103 (Main Classroom) at 0900 on the scheduled graduation date.

MOST COMMON PROBLEMS WHEN REPORTING

- Reporting with no orders and no signature
- NO Screening checklist, incomplete and not signed
- Not screened by Medical officer or Independent Duty Corpsman.
- Not in proper uniform when reporting.
- Required uniforms (basic issue) not complete.
- Personal, marital, financial, medical problems that interfere with training.
- Reporting late with the wrong report time on orders, i.e. 2359.
- Does not meet body composition standards.
- PFT failures.
- Off Duty Education (college): Marines involved in off duty education are allowed to attend providing that it does not impact on the course. These students will not be secured from the training day until after 1630.
