#### RANGE OPERATIONS DIVISION OIC/RSO INFORMATION SHEET (Updated 06 May 2013)

Local OIC/RSO qualification training is required to conduct activity on MCB Camp Pendleton Range and Training Areas.

## Types of OIC & RSO qualifications

Training OIC/RSO – This qualification is required for all types of training (Para Ops, Convoys, HRST, Gas Chambers, Hikes, etc.) and live fire with munitions involving projectiles or explosives. Personnel in this category include Military Personnel, Law Enforcement Officers, Civilian Contractors providing military training and civilian entities conducting live fire under a real estate license. Both Distance Learning Range Safety (DLRS) and local certification are valid for three years. DLRS expiration date and local certification expiration date will coincide with each other. Personnel with <u>DLRS that expire within</u> 90 days or less will not be tested for local range safety certification.

Administrative RSO – This qualification is required for events or activities not related to training. Personnel in this category include construction projects, environmental survey, etc.

Formal OIC & RSO Training Class - To provide comprehensive instruction, a formal class is offered for the Training OIC/RSO qualification. Administrative RSOs will NOT be trained through this class.

Two formal classes will be conducted on the first Thursday of each month; each class is followed by a testing period.

- First Session 0800
- Second Session 0930

- At the first traffic light, take a left onto Wire Mountain Road. Wire Mountain Roadbecomes A Street.
- Take a left on Harbor Road (by the Fire Station)
- Make an immediate left onto B Street heading South.
- Take a left onto 5th Street which leads to the parking lot (on the Right) for the Harbor Side Inn.
- Walk into Sharkey's lounge for the RSO class.
