



- I-5 270m to the north / northeast
- VTOL Pad to the south / southeast
- LHA Pad to the north / northwest

Cultural Lighting: I-5 Highway

Support Equipment: This zone is capable of handling support equipment.

NOTABLE LIMITATIONS: Ground units desiring helicopter support from this site need to contact LONGRIFLE to coordinate opening the gate for access.

Overall Description of zone: LZ Red Beach is 260m south of I-5, but is not on the beach, as its name would imply. It lies between the LHA Pad and the VTOL Pad. In the summer months this zone may be dusty, so anticipate brown-out conditions.

Environmental Issues: This LZ is located within California Gnatcatcher habitat and within 100m of a designated rare plant area.
