


Purpose of zone: Proficiency Training

Elevation: 545'

Slope: Yes slightly downward from northwest to southeast

Surface Type: Hard pack / Soft pack grass

Dimensions in Meters: 40 x 70

Dimensions in Feet: 131 x 230

Aircraft Accommodated: CH-53 and smaller

Hazards/Obstructions in and around the zone:

- Shrubs around the site
- Numerous poles and survey markers

Cultural Lighting: Off-base housing to the northwest

Support Equipment: This site is capable of handling support equipment, but only during dry periods.

NOTABLE LIMITATIONS: None

Overall Description of zone: CAL Site 15 is adjacent to the HLZ pad and lies within AFA 7. The surface is uneven with 2'-3' holes throughout, which makes the surface condition fair to good. There are many sites suitable for landing helicopters in the immediate vicinity.

Environmental Issues: This site is surrounded by California Gnatcatcher habitat and is located adjacent to a vernal pool.
