


Purpose of zone: Proficiency Training

GPS Center Grid Coordinates: WGS 84 / 11SMS 66544 97881

Lat/Long: 33° 25'11"/ 117° 21'35"

Elevation: 1700'

Slope: Slightly downward from southwest to northeast

Surface Type: Rocky hard pack and soft pack

Dimensions in Meters: 20 x 45

Dimensions in Feet: 66 x 148

Aircraft Accommodated: CH-46 and smaller

Hazards/Obstructions in and around the zone:

- Power lines to the northeast and northwest
- Ridgelines surrounding

Support Equipment: This site is *not* capable of handling support equipment.

NOTABLE LIMITATIONS: None

Overall Description of zone: CAL Site 7 is located on a firebreak and is surrounded by ridgelines. An aircraft could land virtually anywhere on the firebreak. The power lines to the northwest run across the valley from west to east and are hard to see, even though they are marked with helicopter hazard warning balls. The power lines to the northeast are also marked. A steeper approach to this zone is required.

Environmental Issues: This site is located within a designated rare plant area.
