





Purpose of zone: Administrative/Troop Lift

Surface Type: Hard pack / Soft pack dirt and grass

Hazards/Obstructions in and around the zone:

- Power lines on top of ridgeline to the northeast running north to south
- Power lines on top of ridgeline to the west
- 50' power lines to the south
- 5'- 10' shrubs surround the zone

Cultural Lighting: Camp San Mateo to the south

Support Equipment: This zone is capable of handling support equipment.

NOTABLE LIMITATIONS: Zone is located in a flood plain

Overall Description of zone: LZ 63 is an extremely long zone. Better for use during the dry season, as the zone is located in a flood plain. Other training areas in close proximity are the HLZ pad, CAL Site 15 and AFA 7, all to the east.

Marked: No

Environmental Issues: This LZ is located in Arroyo Toad habitat. It is also located north of and immediately adjacent to California Gnatcatcher habitat, riparian habitat, and a designated rare plant area.
