Purpose of zone: Administrative

Surface Type: Steel matting

Hazards/Obstructions in and around the zone:

- 25' power line poles to the west
- Power lines 700-800m to the south of the zone on the ridgeline; these power lines stand 300-500' above the zone.

Cultural Lighting: Northwest and immediately west (from Camp Talega)

Support Equipment: This zone is capable of handling support equipment.

NOTABLE LIMITATIONS: The airspace boundary/base physical boundary is 500m north of zone.

Overall Description of zone: LZ 64 is located on the north side of the hard surface road near the Camp Talega main entrance. The center of LZ 64 is steel matting and is clearly marked "LZ 64." The remainder of this LZ is hard pack dirt when dry but will become soft after a day or so of rain; expect landing gear to sink slightly. In the northern part of the zone there are deep ruts from ground vehicles driving through when the ground was soft.

Environmental Issues: This LZ exists within Arroyo Toad habitat and 100m north of riparian habitat.
