RANGE AND TRAINING REGULATIONS

OIC/ RSO Requirements

1. **A safety Brief shall be conducted prior to each live fire event to all participants.**
2. **All personnel shall wear required PPE during all training events.**
3. **OIC & RSO Requirements –**
 - a. **Small Arms-5.56mm and below**
 - i. **OIC Requirement – SSgt or Above**
 - ii. **RSO Requirement - Sgt or Above**
 - b. **No Munitions**
 - i. **OIC Requirement – None**
 - ii. **RSO Requirement - Cpl or Above**
 - iii. **LASER (If Used) LRSO Requirement - Sgt or Above**

Special Instructions

1. All personnel must remain on the catwalk during live fire.
2. All personnel working in the Pit Control Shed shall remain in Pit Control Shed during live fire.
3. The Pits Sentry System will be set up and active during live fire.
4. The Port-a-Johns located in the Butts shall not be used during live fire.
5. No traffic or personnel shall enter the range without the RSO's permission.
6. Prior to conducting table 2 training at the 25 yard line, the RSO shall ensure sand bags are placed on the wooden overhang above the target pullers in order to protect the target carriages and the wooden over hang.
7. Prior to live fire the RSO shall post an air sentry, any time an aircraft is observed lower than 1,000 AGL, the RSO shall call a cease-fire and notify LONGRIFLE.
