RANGE AND TRAINING REGULATIONS

OIC/RSO Requirements

1. **A safety Brief shall be conducted prior to each live fire event to all participants.**
2. **All personnel shall wear required PPE during all training events.**
3. **OIC & RSO Requirements –**
 - a. **Small Arms-7.62mm and below**
 - i. **OIC Requirement – SSgt or Above**
 - ii. **RSO Requirement - Sgt or Above**
 - b. **No Munitions**
 - i. **OIC Requirement – None**
 - ii. **RSO Requirement - Cpl or Above**
 - iii. **LASER (If Used) LRSO Requirement - Sgt or Above**


Special Instructions

1. All personnel must remain on the catwalk during live fire.
2. All personnel working in the Pit Control Shed shall remain in the Pit Control Shed during live fire.
3. The Pits Sentry System shall be set up and active during live fire.
4. POVs are authorized to park in parking lot area without a POV pass
 - a. Personnel shall proceed either on foot or by military vehicle to firing positions, targets, and range butts area.
 - b. Civilian vehicles **shall NOT be used** for this purpose.
 - c. Range Personnel vehicles are authorized at all locations on the range.
 - d. Only the safety vehicle and the ammo shall be allowed to remain down range behind the firing line, all other vehicles must be moved back to the parking lot.
5. The Port-a-Johns located in the Butts shall not be used during live fire.
6. No traffic or personnel shall enter the range without the RSO's permission.
7. Prior to conducting table 2 training at the 25 yard line, the RSO shall ensure sand bags are placed on the wooden overhang above the target pullers in order to protect the target carriages and the wooden over hang.
8. Prior to conducting table 2 training at the 25 yard line, the RSO shall ensure sand bags are placed on the metal H-Stand target frames to prevent any ricochet.
