GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- A safety Brief will be conducted prior to each live fire event to all participants.**
- IOT occupy this range unit must have the following personnel/equipment:
 - RSO
 - Corpsman & Safety Vehicle
 - Positive Communication with LONGRIFLE
 - If ammunition is present on range - Ammo Guards will be armed.
- IOT go into a hot status on range unit must have the following personnel/equipment:
 - OIC
 - RSO
 - Corpsman & Safety Vehicle
 - Positive Communication with LONGRIFLE
- RSO will verify the left and right lateral limits utilizing a compass and map.**
 - Overall range lateral limits will be identified.
 - Each firing position lateral limits will be identified.
- The RSO & OIC will personally observe each live fire event.
- A signed ORM must be on hand IOT conduct training.**
- A non-participating Corpsman will be stationed with safety vehicle.**
- A full rehearsal will be conducted prior to live fire.**
- Unit is required mark/post signs for any lateral limits and/or MSLs listed in this brief if not already marked/posted.**
- Minimum engagement distances for RETS or PITS targets is as follows:**
 - 25 meters – 5.56mm
 - 100 meters – 7.62mm and above (**.50 on vehicle targets only**)
- At no time will any unit go from live fire to blank or SESAMS force-on-force within a 24 hour period**
- At any time Range guards are required, they will be posted in pairs with positive communication with the RSO.**
- Ammunition will only be issued per event and accounted for on NAVMC 11381.
- After each event, unit leaders will conduct a line out.
- Each RSO will certify to the OIC that all weapons are in Condition 4 prior to exiting the range and all ammunition is accounted for.
- Helmets and flak jackets shall be worn for the following live fire training events:
 - Live fire and movement/maneuver.
 - High explosives or grenades.
 - Machineguns.
 - Close Quarters Battle in shoot houses.
- Ensure all weapons are cleared and inspected prior to departing the firing line.
- All weapon malfunctions shall be corrected per the appropriate TM/FM, and unit SOP.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. At no time will any engagements be made at any target above the left and right lateral limits signs.
2. All M249/M240G BZO and 10 meter qualification will be conducted using pallet from the field firing line.
 - a. Any engineer stakes used for pallets must be placed on the outside edges of the pallets.
3. For all EMP training
 - a. Targets are only permitted to be placed, inside the established EMP/CMP Box.
 - b. All EMP targets must be of softwood uprights, cardboard backing paper or cardboard targets.
 - c. Any metal bases used must be soft metal.
4. When firing Rockets, the OIC shall ensure that a Range Guard is posted at entrance to range.
