

1. 1st MSOB Sponsored Units Must Submit Requests through 1st MSOB.
2. SOTG Sponsored units must submit requests through SOTG.
3. Final approval & scheduling of this range must be submitted to Range Scheduling.

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General Instructions

1. A safety Brief will be conducted prior to each live fire event to all participants.
2. All personnel shall wear required PPE during all training events.
3. OIC & RSO Requirements -
 - a. Live Fire, SESAMS, Flash Bangs & BFX
 - i. OIC Requirement – GySgt or Above
 - ii. RSO Requirement - SSgt or Above
 - b. Blanks
 - i. OIC Requirement – SSgt or Above
 - ii. RSO Requirement - Sgt or Above
 - c. No Munitions
 - i. OIC Requirement – None
 - ii. RSO Requirement - Cpl or Above
 - iii. LASER (If Used) LSSO Requirement - Sgt or Above
4. IOT occupy this range unit must have the following personnel/equipment:
 - a. RSO
 - b. Corpsman & Safety Vehicle
 - c. Positive Communication with LONGRIFLE
 - d. An ORM reviewed and signed by the Command, RSO and OIC.
5. IOT go into a hot status on range unit must have the following personnel/ equipment:
 - a. OIC
 - b. RSO
 - c. LSSO – If using Laser
 - d. Corpsman & Safety Vehicle
 - e. Positive Communication with LONGRIFLE
 - f. NAVMC 11381 filled out by the OIC.
6. The RSO & OIC will personally observe each event.
7. There shall be additional safety personnel assigned as follows:
 - a. Weapons Qualified PSOs
 - i. Daylight - shall be assigned one per every FOUR Shooters.
 - ii. Night - shall be assigned one per every TWO Shooters.
 - b. PSOs shall certify to the OIC that all weapons are in Condition 4 prior to exiting the range.
8. A non-participating Corpsman will be stationed with safety vehicle.
9. Ammunition will only be issued per event and accounted for on NAVMC 11381.
10. After each event, unit leaders will conduct a line out.
11. Each RSO/PSO will certify to the OIC that all weapons are in Condition 4 prior to exiting the range/ facility and all ammunition is accounted for.
12. All weapon malfunctions shall be corrected per the appropriate TM/FM, and unit SOP.

Special Instructions

1. At no time will any unit (Marine/ Other Military Services) utilize R130I without the presence of an 1st MSOB/ SOTG Instructor who must be a valid Camp Pendleton OIC/RSO.
2. When personnel are required to move down range all weapons must be condition 4.
3. At no time will targets be placed down range at an altitude greater than 575' MSL.
4. Steel targets –
 - a. All pistol & Shotgun engagements will be conducted IAW SOUM 2-02.
 - b. At no time will rifle engagements be closer than 100 yards.
5. Sniper House Static Fire–
 - a. A qualified OIC/RSO instructor from 1st MSOB/ SOTG shall position themselves in a safe position to ensure that no personnel cross or enter the GTL and shall verify bore line to ensure projectile path is free of obstructions.
 - b. When shooting from the upper and lower decks no personnel on the lower decks shall be located forward of the upper deck position.
 - c. Steel balcony rails are to be removed when firing from the rooms located in the upper deck.
 - d. When firing from the balcony, rails may be left in place as long a muzzles are forward of rails.

6. Sniper House Movement Drills Through House –
 - a. A qualified OIC/RSO instructor from 1st MSOB/ SOTG shall ensure that the following conditions are met:
 - i. Weapons in Condition 3
 - ii. Positive control of weapon
 - iii. Four safety rules in effect
7. Sniper House Movement Drills to Tower or Roof Position –
 - a. A qualified OIC/RSO instructor from 1st MSOB/ SOTG shall ensure that the following conditions are met:
 - i. Weapons in Condition 3
 - ii. Weapon must be slung to allow a shooter to climb the tower ladder and utilize trap door.
 - iii. **At no time will a shooter be allowed to climb the tower ladder with weapon in hand.**
 - iv. **No personnel in the lower decks are to be located forward of the upper positions**
 - v. Four safety rules in effect
8. Stress drills that involve movement from locations on the R130 Complex to R130I are authorized. All weapons must be in condition 3.
9. **Firing into the Sniper House from R130J 1-3 (Sniper Hides) is authorized under the following conditions:**
 - a. All targets are placed within the listed Lateral Limits.
 - b. Steel bullet traps rated for rifle fire are in place.
 - c. Targets placed forward of the Sniper House present a clear projectile path and do not require a bullet trap.
10. For all EMP training:
 - a. Must be completed forward of the Sniper House.
 - b. All EMP targets must be of softwood uprights, cardboard backing paper or cardboard targets. Any metal bases used must be soft metal.
