

Retirees - ID Card Issuance & Renewals

To update status to Retired in DEERS, the following documents are required:

1. Active Duty Retiree - Retirement Orders and/or DD Form 214 (Member Copy 4).
2. Two (2) forms of valid unexpired identification, one form MUST be a photo ID.

Retirees will not be issued their initial Retiree ID card prior to their retirement date. Eligible dependents of retirees will also need to replace their dependent ID cards to reflect the retiree's change in status.

The Retiree ID card will state the card is indefinite but on the backside of the card it will have an expiration date for the 65th Birthday. At 65, retirees are eligible for Medicare and require a new Retiree ID card after the Medicare Part A and B election has been made.
