California Legal Requirements for Homeschooling

California Education Code (EC) Section 33190 states that persons, firms, associations, partnerships, or corporations offering or conducting private school instruction at the elementary or high school level for students between the ages of six and eighteen years shall file the Private School Affidavit (PSA) between October 1 and 15.

Homeschooling Laws and Regulations by State - When you are physically present in a state, even temporarily, you are subject to that state's laws, and, in many cases, to the jurisdiction of its courts. This is true even if your legal residency is in another state and you are only living elsewhere temporarily (such as when active members of the military are completing a temporary assignment). <http://www.hslida.org/laws/default.asp>

DoDEA's Policy on Homeschooling - It is DoDEA policy neither to encourage nor discourage DoD sponsors from home schooling their minor dependents. DoDEA recognizes that home schooling is a sponsor's right and can be a legitimate alternative form of education for the sponsor's dependents. Sponsors are responsible for complying with the applicable requirements of their host nation, state, commonwealth or territory. <http://www.dodea.edu/>

Families have the additional option to use a charter or virtual school. These are considered public schools and the curriculum is funded with no cost to parents. Some charter schools also have a school based component where students attend the school site for classes in addition to the independent learning model. Stu-

dents meet with their teacher weekly to review lessons and assignments. If you decide to use one of the charter or virtual schools, they file all necessary paperwork on your behalf.
