It's that time of the year again! To ensure that your children have a safe and fun time trick-or-treating, keep the following tips in mind:

- Decorate costumes, bags and sacks with reflective tape/stickers or carry a flashlight so people can see you. Reflectors make your children visible at 500 feet. Ensure candy is commercially wrapped and stay on the sidewalk.
- Choose a costume that won't easily ignite and avoid long trailing fabrics. If your child is wearing a mask, cut oversized eye holes for better vision at night.
- Provide children with flashlights or glow sticks to carry for lighting. It is safest to use a flashlight or battery operated candles in a jack-o-lantern. Tell children to stay away from open flames.
