

## Warehousing Safety

## **Materials Storage**

- Stack loads evenly and straight;
- Place heavier loads on lower or middle shelves;
- Remove one object at a time from shelves;
- Keep aisles and passageways clear and in good repair.





## **Forklifts**

- Train, evaluate and certify all operators to ensure they can operate forklifts safely;
- Before using a forklift, examine it for hazardous conditions which would make it unsafe to operate;
- Follow safe procedures for picking up, putting down and stacking loads;
- Drive safely, never exceed 5 mph & slow down in congested areas.
- ALWAYS WEAR YOUR SEATBELT!

## Potential hazards for workers in warehousing

Unsafe use of forklifts; Improper stacking of products;

Failure to use proper personal protective equipment;
Failure to follow proper lockout/tagout procedures;
Inadequate fire safety provisions; or
Repetitive motion injuries.
