

## **PUBLIC NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY**

### **FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT FOR THE BASILONE ROAD LANDSLIDE REPAIR AT MARINE CORPS BASE CAMP PENDLETON, CALIFORNIA**

In accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), 42 U.S.C. §§ 4321 et seq, Marine Corps Order 5090.2, and the Department of the Navy procedures/regulations implementing NEPA at 32 C.F.R. Part 775, an Environmental Assessment (EA) and Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) has been prepared for the proposed Basilone Road Landslide Repair at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, and an Environmental Impact Statement is not required.

The Proposed Action is to repair damage to approximately 2,300 feet of Basilone Road and the utilities present that resulted from a slow-moving landslide between the 51 and 52 Area and an additional sewer-leak induced landslide that further destabilized the roadway within the already impacted area that will be repaired along with the original landslide damage to Basilone Road. Based on the EA analysis, the preferred alternative will have negligible direct, indirect, or cumulative impacts on the quality of the environment and will comply with all regulatory requirements; no significant impacts will occur.
