

Pest Management Contracts



These requirements apply to all Service Providers preforming pest control, grounds maintenance, resources management, or other pest management services on Marine Corps Base (MCB) Camp Pendleton, including leased lands and facilities. This includes contractors providing services for base operating services, invasive species management, DoD housing, agricultural leased property, Marine Corps exchange facilities, MCCS services, and DeCA.

- 1. Only State licensed or certified applicators shall apply pesticides on MCB Camp Pendleton. The contractor must provide their government representative with a list or copy of pesticide applicators and their certification/license information. The government representative will provide this information to the Installation Pest Management Coordinator to be included in the Integrated Pest Management Plan via the NAVFAC Online Pesticide Reporting System (NOPRS).
- 2. All pesticides applied on the Installation must be approved for use by the Installation and the Department of Navy (DoN) regional Pest Management Consultant. Approved pesticides will be included on the installation pesticide authorized use list, which will be maintained on NOPRS.
- 3. Contractors shall use Integrated Pest Management (IPM) tactics and all pesticides shall be applied in accordance with the pesticide product label and Safety Data Sheets.
- 4. All Pest Management activities, both chemical and non-chemical, shall be reported to the Installation Integrated Pest Management Coordinator and the DoN using NOPRS. Reporting should be done on no less than a weekly basis. Privatized Housing Managers are required to receive and maintain pest management records from their contractors and make them accessible to the installation.
