

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY  
FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT  
PROPOSED POTABLE WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS (P-079)  
MARINE CORPS BASE CAMP PENDLETON, CALIFORNIA**

The U.S. Marine Corps (USMC) has prepared an Environmental Assessment/Finding of No Significant Impact (EA/FONSI) for improvements to the existing potable water distribution system that supplies water from the 24 Area to the 20 and 21 Areas at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California. Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, as amended (42 United States Code §§ 4321-4370h), the USMC gives notice that an Environmental Impact Statement is not required.

Under the Proposed Action, the existing potable water distribution pipeline from the 24 Area to the 20 and 21 Areas will be replaced with a new potable water distribution pipeline. Three existing booster pump stations will be replaced and upgraded. In addition, an existing elevated water tank will be demolished and replaced with a new tank.
