Base access requirements: Trusted Traveler and Escorted Access Request

Trusted Traveler access allows a person with DoD affiliation to present their approved credential and vouch for up to five adult co-travelers. Co-travelers must be 16 years of age or older, and can be on foot, in the same vehicle, or in a single vehicle following immediately behind the sponsor's vehicle. The co-traveler(s) must establish their identity through acceptable credentials or identification when prompted. Co-travelers may not be foreign nationals.

Must have a Real ID.

Base access requirements: Foreign National Visitor Request

Foreign Nationals are prohibited from being Co-Travelers under the Trusted Traveler policy and MUST have a DBIDS credential.

If you have an unofficial Foreign National visitor; you MUST take the visitor to the Camp Pendleton Visitor Center for screening and DBIDS credential issuance. Sponsors MUST notify the Visitor Center 96 hours prior to the Foreign National's arrival on Camp Pendleton.

This allows the Visitor Center sufficient time to submit their information for background checks and screening by the Marine Corps Intelligence Activity (MCIA). Once screened, the VC will issue the FN a DBIDS credential with restricted markings to identify the visitor as a FN.

The FN must then be escorted by the DoD Affiliate sponsor at all times and is not permitted unescorted access.

Steps to Follow for Sponsors of Foreign Nationals:

- 1) The DoD Affiliate sponsor must notify the Camp Pendleton Visitor Center a minimum of 96 hours prior to the Foreign National's arrival.
- 2) The Foreign National must be escorted by the DoD Affiliate sponsor to the Visitor Center for screening and DBIDS credential issuance.
- 3) Once screened, the Visitor Center will issue the Foreign National a DBIDS credential, with restricted markings, to properly identify the visitor.
- 4) The Foreign National must then be escorted by the DoD Affiliate sponsor to the gate and must always remain with the Foreign National, as unescorted access is not permitted!
