Spring Safety:

With warmer weather and increased activity across the installation, May is a great time to stay sharp on everyday safety. Whether you're in the barracks, housing, or working areas, simple precautions help protect our entire community.

Lock It, Secure It

The majority of thefts on base are crimes of opportunity.

- Lock your barracks room, residence, and vehicles at all times
- Do not leave valuables unattended in shared or common areas
- Secure bikes, scooters, and gear with quality locks

POV & Motorcycle Safety

Personally owned vehicle (POV) and motorcycle thefts can be prevented with basic steps:

- Never leave keys or key fobs inside your vehicle
- Park in well-lit, designated areas
- Use anti-theft devices when possible
- Riders: always secure helmets and gear when not in use

Package & Mail Security

Deliveries are convenient, but can be targeted if left unattended.

- Pick up packages promptly from mailrooms or doorsteps
- Coordinate with neighbors or unit members if you're unavailable
- Consider delivery options that require pickup or signature

See Something, Say Something

Staying alert helps protect everyone aboard the installation.

- Report suspicious persons or activity immediately
- Avoid distractions while walking or moving through parking areas
- Trust your instincts and speak up

Barracks & Housing Safety

- Do not allow unknown individuals into secured buildings
- Ensure doors latch properly behind you
- Report broken locks, doors, or lighting to your chain of command or facilities

Leave & Travel Reminders

Heading out on leave?

- Secure all personal belongings before departure
- Let a trusted friend or neighbor know you'll be gone
- Avoid posting travel plans in real time on social media

Strong Community = Strong Security

Camp Pendleton is strongest when we look out for one another.

- Know your neighbors and fellow Marines/Sailors
- Share safety concerns early
- Support a culture of accountability and awareness

Wildlife Safety

You share this space with wildlife. Know how to react.

Mountain Lions:

DO NOT RUN. Face the lion, look large, and make noise. Avoid hiking alone at dawn, dusk, or night.

Coyotes:

DO NOT RUN or turn your back. Make loud noises to scare them off. Keep pets attended and on a leash.

Venomous Snakes:

DO NOT attempt to remove them. Call the Game Warden immediately. Wear closed-toe shoes and watch your step.

Raccoons:

Do not approach; they can be aggressive.

General Safety Rules:

- NEVER feed wild animals.
- Keep pets indoors at night and ensure they are vaccinated.
- Secure all trash cans to avoid attracting animals.
- Keep your yard clear of tall grass and bushes where animals can hide.
