California Legal Requirements for Homeschooling

California Education Code (EC) Section 33190 states that persons, firms, associations, partnerships, or corporations offering or conducting private school instruction at the elementary or high school level for students between the ages of six and eighteen years shall file the Private School Affidavit (PSA) between October 1 and 15. http://www.cde.ca.gov/sp/ps/rq/affidavit.asp

Homeschooling Laws and Regulations by State - When you are physically present in a state, even temporarily, you are subject to that state's laws, and, in many cases, to the jurisdiction of its courts. This is true even if your legal residency is in another state and you are only living elsewhere temporarily (such as when active members of the military are completing a temporary assignment). http://www.hslda.org/laws/default.asp

DoDEA's Policy on Homeschooling - It is DoDEA policy neither to encourage nor discourage DoD sponsors from home schooling their minor dependents. DoDEA recognizes that home schooling is a sponsor's right and can be a legitimate alternative form of education for the sponsor's dependents.
