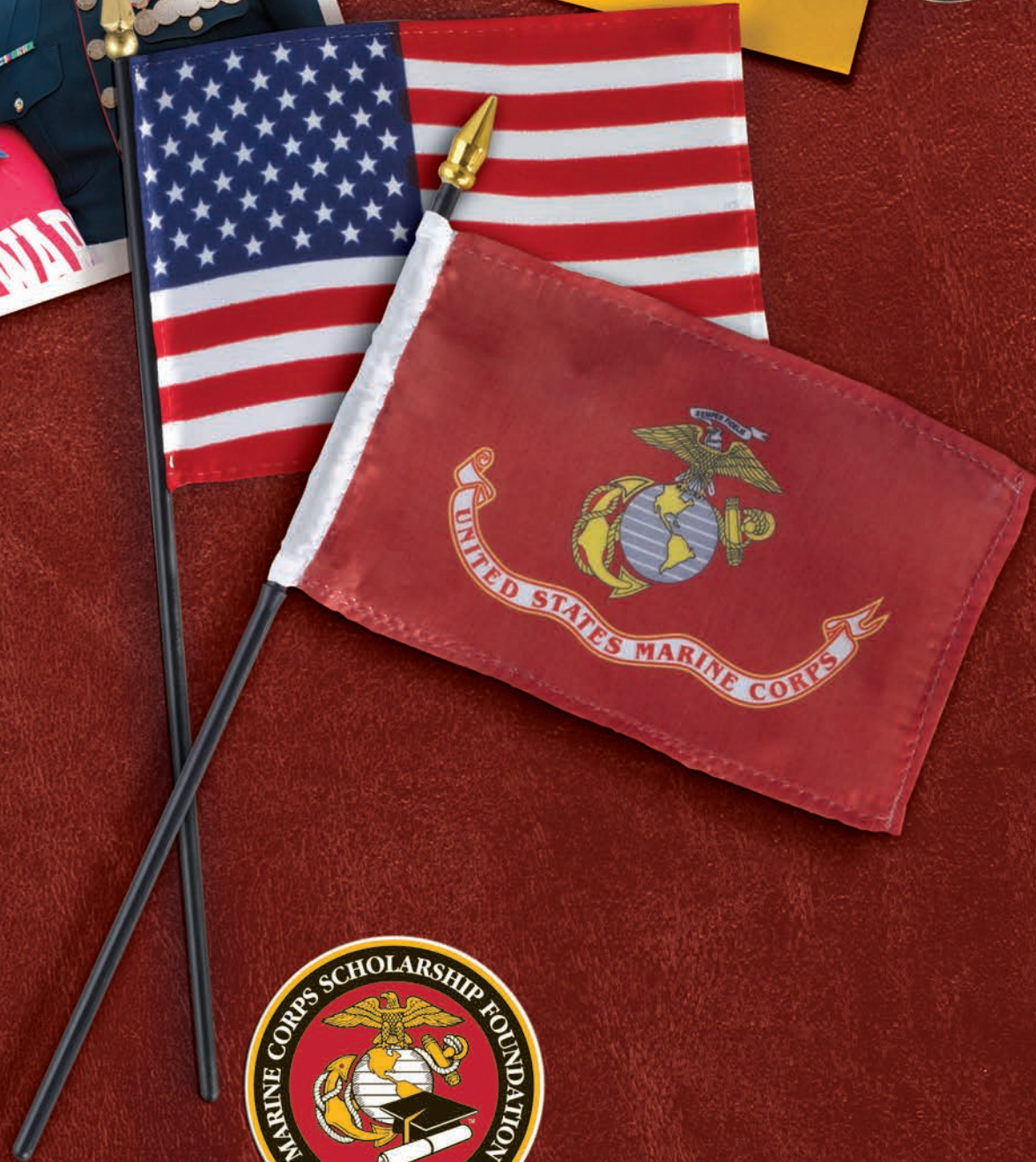

## Eligibility Criteria

The Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation awards need-based scholarships to the children of the following:

- ★ Active Duty or Reserve U.S. Marines
- ★ Veteran U.S. Marines who have received an honorable discharge, medical discharge, were wounded, or were killed while serving in the U.S. Marine Corps
- ★ Active Duty or Reserve U.S. Navy Corpsmen who are serving, or have served with a U.S. Marine Unit
- ★ Veteran U.S. Navy Corpsmen who have served with a U.S. Marine unit and have received an honorable discharge, medical discharge, were wounded, or were killed while serving in the U.S. Navy

Additionally, applicants must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- ★ Planning to attend an accredited undergraduate college or vocational/technical institution in the upcoming academic year
- ★ A GPA of at least 2.0
- ★ An income requirement must be met
- ★ Special funding is available for the children of those who were wounded or killed in combat
