

# TIPS TO CLEAN UP MOLD



## SELF HELP

If the affected area is less than 10' x 10', self help is authorized. FMD Service Request is required for affected areas more than 100 sq. ft.



## TOSS!

Take it out! Anything that was wet and can't be cleaned and dried completely within 24 to 48 hours. Utilize appropriate PPE (gloves, goggles, mask)



## AIR IT OUT

If the weather permits, open all doors and windows to air out the area.



## Circulate

When electricity is safe to use, use fans and dehumidifiers to remove moisture and circulate the air.



## DON'T MIX

Never mix chlorine bleach solution with other cleaning solutions or detergents that contain ammonia.



## DON'T COVER

Painting or caulking over mold will not prevent mold from growing.



## SCRUB SURFACES

Clean with water and a detergent. Remove all mold you can see. Dry right away.



## CLEAN UP

Utilize a High-Efficiency Particulate Air (HEPA) vacuum and dry everything as quickly as possible – within 24 to 48 hours if you can.
