- To proactively identify and mitigate hazards in the workplace.

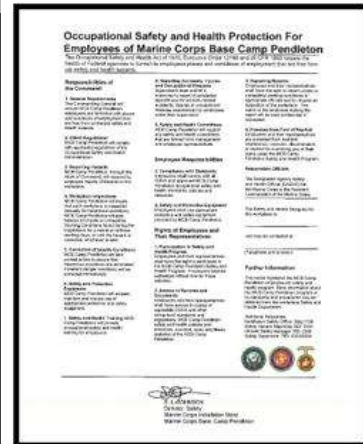
**Commitment:** We are dedicated to continuous improvement in our safety performance and encourage everyone to contribute to a safe workplace.
