It's Wildfire Season!

In 2025, wildfires in California have already exceeded the total number of wildfires (1,647) in 2024. According to the National Interagency Fire Center, on average wildfires are projected to be more severe depending on where you live in the state. The fire center reported that Central and Southern California received "significantly below average precipitation" since the water year began Oct. 1. Southern California is unfortunately projected to have another highly active fire season.



What Can You Do To Prepare?

Here are some things you can do to prepare:

- Maintain a defensible space around your home (consult your housing office for regulations).
- Ensure all combustible materials are discarded or stored 30 feet away from your home
- Create an Evacuation Plan and know when to evacuate.
*Always evacuate early!!!
- Assemble an Emergency Supply Kit.
- Fill-out a Family Communication Plan that includes important evacuation and contact information.

iWALK Magnetic Wireless Power Bank

Hazard: The lithium-ion batteries in the recalled power banks can overheat and ignite, posing a risk of serious injury or death from fire and burn hazards to consumers.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled power banks and contact U2O Global for a full refund. To receive a refund, consumers should send a photo of the recalled power bank, showing the model number and the serial number, with “Recalled” written on the power bank in permanent marker to U2O Global by email at service@iwalk.net. Consumers should dispose of the recalled power banks in accordance with local hazardous waste disposal procedures.
