What is Assembly Bill 413 – California’s Daylighting Law?

Improving Pedestrian Safety On and Off Base

What is AB 413?

- Prohibits parking within 20 feet of a crosswalk to improve pedestrian visibility and reduce traffic accidents. The law applies to all public roads, including those near military installations.

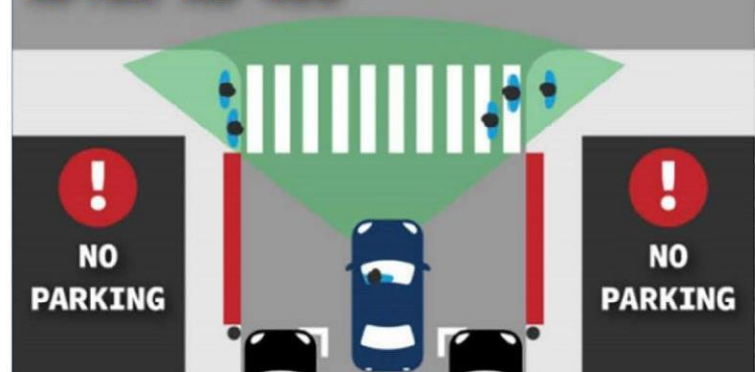
Why it’s Important

- Enhances Safety - Increases visibility at intersections, reducing the risk of pedestrian accidents.
- Reduced Blind Spots - Ensures drivers and pedestrians can see each other clearly.
- Compliance with State Law - Military personnel must follow California traffic laws both on and off base.
- Impact on base operations
- Parking Adjustments - Parking spots near crosswalks may be removed or relocated.
- Traffic Flow - Drivers should be aware of new no-parking zones around crosswalks.
- Enforcement - Base security and military police ensures compliance and safety.

What You Need to Do

- Do not park within 20 feet of crosswalks whether on base or off base.
- Stay alert for new signage and pavement markings indicating restricted parking zones.
