

TRAUMA SITE CLEAN-UP (BBP)

PLEASE DO NOT CALL 911.

- 1. Trauma Incidents:** Unforeseen trauma incidents can significantly impact both personnel and facilities aboard an installation. These incidents may include workplace accidents, deaths, suicides, homicides, or other biological situations.
- 2. Hazards of Cleaning Trauma Sites:** Trauma sites can be hazardous due to bloodborne pathogens. These pathogens are infectious microorganisms found in human blood and other body fluids. As a result, command personnel should never attempt to clean a trauma site themselves.
- 3. Certified Professional Clean-Up:** Biohazard clean-ups should be performed by certified professionals. These experts have the necessary training, equipment, and knowledge to safely handle such situations. Their expertise ensures that personnel are not exposed to dangerous pathogens during the clean-up process.
- 4. Contact Information:** Tenant commands, organizations, and activities aboard Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton should use the provided contact number to request biohazard clean-up services.
