WHEREAS, 24 March 2021 is Personally Identifiable Information Awareness Day, a time to provide information and guidance on the safeguarding, maintenance, and handling of personal information (<http://www.doncio.navy.mil/TagResults.aspx?ID=36>); and


WHEREAS, The Privacy Act of 1974, 5 U.S.C. § 552a establishes a code of fair information practices that govern the collection, maintenance, use, and dissemination of information about individuals that are maintained in systems of records by federal agencies; and

WHEREAS, to conduct a thorough review of all directives, instructions, and policies to ensure procedures are in place to minimize the opportunities for loss or compromise of Personally Identifiable Information; and

WHEREAS, the privacy of an individual is imperative and is required through the Privacy Act Program, Marine Corps Installations West-Marine Corps Base, Camp Pendleton; and

WHEREAS, to ensure, either directly or indirectly, that all military, civilian, and contract personnel within the command receive required annual Personally Identifiable Information training via the Total Workforce Management Services website (<https://twms.dc3n.navy.mil/my.policy>) for civilians and via MarineNet (<https://www.marinenet.usmc.mil/my.policy>) for military; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in recognition of the valuable work done within the coordinated efforts of the Personally Identifiable Information Program, I, Brigadier General Dan Conley, do hereby proclaim 24 March 2021 as **Personally Identifiable Information Awareness Day**.
